

## CANADIAN CHARTER OF RIGHTS AND FREEDOMS SCAVENGER HUNT

1. Section 2 states that everyone has four fundamental freedoms. These include freedom of conscience and \_\_\_\_\_; freedom of thought, opinion, belief, and \_\_\_\_\_; freedom of \_\_\_\_\_; and freedom of \_\_\_\_\_.

10. It is important to remember that your rights are not absolute. Section 1 guarantees the rights and freedoms set out in it subject only to such \_\_\_\_\_ prescribed by law as can be demonstrably \_\_\_\_\_ in a free and democratic society.

Section 24(2) states that where a court concludes that evidence was obtained in a manner that infringed or denied any rights or freedoms guaranteed by the Charter, the evidence shall be \_\_\_\_\_ if it is established that, having regard to all the circumstances, allowing it would bring the \_\_\_\_\_ of justice into \_\_\_\_\_.
